The "Beekeeping for Healthy Biodiversity" project is a community-based environmental initiative by Nava Jeevan Convent in Barasat, West Bengal. The land is fertile with abundant vegetation and flowers providing an ideal habitat for bees and other pollinators. This project aims to conserve biodiversity through sustainable beekeeping, mushroom cultivation, and vermicomposting, while simultaneously empowering women and farmers through Self-Help Groups (SHGs). By partnering with Bee Active, a Kolkata-based ecological training group, the sisters and community members will receive hands-on training in eco-friendly practices. The initiative will boost crop yields, promote food security, generate income from organic honey and bee products, and foster environmental awareness to the beneficiaries.

MOTHER AND CHILD NUTRITION PROGRAM

Kontum, Vietnam

Kontum is a diocese in the Central Highlands, near the borders of Laos and Cambodia. The majority of the population is ethnic Bahnar, who live in remote areas. We are called to serve these people, in five villages. Women and children suffer from malnutrition due to poverty, food insecurity, and lack of access to essential nutrients like protein, calcium, and vitamins. These issues lead to long-term health problems such as stunted growth, weakened immunity, anemia, and complications during pregnancy. This project is aimed at providing milk and nutritious food to children and women living in poverty to improve their health and help them live with dignity.
