## Machakos, KENYA Training centre for Empowering Women

The Muuo centre offers skills in beadwork, candle making, garment printing, mug printing, curtain making, knitting, tailoring and dressmaking. Currently there are twenty one women. There are outreach programs working with women in different villages in smaller groups. We train them in different activities and journey with them closely. The students at our centre actively participate in learning skills and are doing very well in production. Two of the women have undergone full knitting training and are sharing with others and are producing well. Their confidence is growing and they are able to teach others and are eligible to be employed. When a big order is received, the students are employed casually to do the production. This helps them to earn a livelihood and the centre also earns some income which is used for running costs. The Muuo centre is open to welcome young women who are interested to acquire the skill of knitting. Thank you for contributing to this project.

## **Cherrapunjee, INDIA NORTH EAST** **Benefitting from electrical stability**

St. John Bosco Girls' Higher Secondary School is one of the most prestigious schools in Cherrapunjee. It has always catered to marginalized, orphaned children and children with single parents. The existing classrooms do not have sufficient brightness due to the thick mist during the monsoon season, which lasts from May to October. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we were able to install an inverter which made a significant difference to the the school and the mindset of the students. A portable inverter provides power to tools and appliances when supplementary electricity is needed. At present we are able to use the portable inverter to power essential small appliances, such as lights, Xerox machines, computers, and printers. The beneficiaries of this project are 355 students as well as the teachers and the sisters involved. Thank you for your generosity.

### **Nutrition program for children**

With the help of this project, we were able to reach out to children who come to our dispensary with low weight who are not growing according to their age, due to anemia and dehydration as a result of poverty. Every month we welcome at least 40 to 50 of these children. The enriched flour composed of millet, maize, beans, groundnuts, moringa, as well as some vitamins has been a great help for them. There are also new-born babies who lost their mothers at birth whom we were able to feed after 6 months.

We noticed that malnourished children began to increase their weight and height according to their age. Children with anemia began to gain back their health. We were able to save many children's lives. The parents were very happy to see that their child gained back their normal weight and now enjoy good health.

We are grateful to all donors who made all this possible.
